- Core Subjects: All 8th graders must pass a full year of each of the four core subjects. Final Placement will be determined by State Assessment scores.
- Advanced course prerequisite: Level 3 or above on the most current required state assessment.
- **High School Course Requirements:** Pre-AP English & Pre-AP World Hist/Geography must have a: 4 or higher on ELA FAST. Algebra 1 Honors: 3 or higher on Mathematics FAST and 3.5+GPA in 7<sup>th</sup> grade Accelerated Mathematics. Geometry Honors: C or higher in each semester of Algebra 1 Honors and must have passed the Algebra EOC. Spanish 1: 4 or higher on the ELA FAST. Spanish 2: 4 or higher of ELA FAST and 3.0+ in Spanish 1.
- \*STEAM TEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math) Application is Required. Students must score a 3 or above on the FAST ELA and Math Test. STEAM students must maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA in all core courses and have an excellent background in class and homework assignments. Students must have a proven record of responsibly maintaining materials and equipment.
