### Welcome & Opening

- Introductions

### State of the School

- Principal: The school fared ok after Hurricane Milton. South campus gym suffered the most. Waiting for contractor meeting which takes place on Tuesdays (the day after SAC). Freshman & sophomores took reading test, progress monitoring. Ninth grade had 37% proficiency. Tenth grade had 32% proficiency. Tenth graders will take the PSAT on the 23rd at no cost. Mrs. Fleming addressed the football game on Friday night, October 18th. There was rumors there was a gun. There was NO gun at the game. There was a fight which led to a couple people being tased by the police & removed from the game. The game continued without incident.
- Non-Instructional: Mrs. Norris discussed the students recognized for their academic talent. National Merit Semifinalist is Henry Leatham. Commended Scholars are Audrey Yanevich & John Gerber. There is a FAFSA workshop on October 24th. FAFSA opens in December. There will be workshops in January to help.
