

Time Guideline for Selecting Courses at SCF

Students must maintain 3.5 high school credits per semester. The only exception is for juniors who are in the ADE program or seniors in Early Admissions.

NOTE: If a student cannot meet the 3.5 credit requirement through MHS/SCF, he/she will be required to take additional courses through FLVS/MVS to meet the 3.5 credit/semester requirement.

If Taking 1 class at SCF:

If it's a morning class at SCF that counts as a ½ credit – Students must be at MHS by 8:15 a.m.
If it's a morning class at SCF that counts as a 1.0 credit – Students must be at MHS by 9:10 a.m.

If it's an afternoon/evening class that counts as ½ credit – Students will be able to leave MHS at 1:25 p.m.
If it's an afternoon/evening class that counts as 1.0 credit – Students will be able to leave MHS at 12:30 p.m.

If Taking 2 classes at SCF:

If taking morning classes that total 1.0 credit – Students must be at MHS by 9:10 a.m.
If taking morning classes that total 1.5 credits – Students must be at MHS by 10:05 a.m.
If taking morning classes that total 2.0 credits – Students must be at MHS by 11:00 a.m.

If taking afternoon/evening classes that total 1.0 credit – Students will be able to leave MHS at 12:30 p.m.
If taking afternoon/evening classes that total 1.5 credits – Students will be able to leave MHS at 11:05 a.m.
If taking afternoon/evening classes that total 2.0 credits – Students will be able to leave MHS at 10:10 a.m.

If Taking 3 classes at SCF:

If taking morning classes that total 1.5 credits – Students must be at MHS by 10:05 a.m.
If taking morning classes that total 2.0 credits – Students must be at MHS by 11:00 a.m.
If taking morning classes that total 2.5 credits – Students must be at MHS by 12:30 p.m.
If taking morning classes that total 3.0 credits – Students must be at MHS by 1:20 p.m.

If taking afternoon/evening classes that total 1.5 credits – Students will be able to leave MHS at 11:05 a.m.
If taking afternoon/evening classes that total 2.0 credits – Students will be able to leave MHS at 10:10 a.m.
If taking afternoon/evening classes that total 2.5 credits – Students will be able to leave MHS at 9:15 a.m.
If taking afternoon/evening classes that total 3.0 credits – Students will be able to leave MHS at 8:20 a.m.
