An overall academic average of 2.5 or above is required to be maintained quarterly. Dancer must be a student of Manatee High School (or 8th grader who is registered to be a Freshman of MHS for the 2025-2026 academic year) to be eligible.

To audition you must wear appropriate dance/exercise wear including dance shoes (jazz shoes, ballet shoes, dance sneakers, etc...cannot be barefoot. Wear ALL BLACK for ALL audition days! Hair must be pulled back in a ponytail or bun (or out of face if too short for a ponytail or

bun). Please do not wear jewelry!

With regards to the summer months, there is an allowance of two absences per month before demerits are accrued for unexcused absences. It is understood that families have planned vacations over the summer (please advise dates at your earliest convenience), but please note that all team members MUST be in attendance at the two scheduled practices the week prior to camp! Those two practices are **absolutely MANDATORY!** Also note that during the school year, an occasional Saturday or Sunday practice may be added if necessary when working toward a big performance and/or competition. An event calendar will be provided to the dancers, as they are the ones responsible for their schedule.

*These fees pay for band fees, band gear, band shoes, insurance, bus transportation, meals, practice shirts, practice shorts, earrings, hair bows, poms, backpack, jackets, warmups, uniform tops, choreographers, costumes, music etc.

*Uniforms will only need to be ordered **once** and will be used during the duration of your time as a Sugar Cane. If you are returning and want a new uniform please communicate that with coaches asap. * Competition fee covers the cost of the dancer's registration for all competitions as well as hotel for nationals.

Please be aware that the above is an **estimate** of costs. Every effort will be made to stay within these guidelines, but please understand that sometimes changes occur, or additional expenses may arise. Fundraisers and Sponsorship Drive will be held to help with various team expenses. **All dancers MUST participate in the fundraisers held for the team!**

Additional Expenses:

There will be items to purchase on your own. A supply list will be provided at New Team meeting.

Competition Team MAY be in charge of purchasing costumes. Each is roughly \$150-\$250 each. (2 costumes)

Competition Team has a choreo fee of \$85 due on July 1st.

Expectations:

Upon making the team, there will be a **Mandatory Parent/Team Meeting on Friday, April 29th from 6:00-7:00 pm in the MHS Theatre**, at which time your initial payment of. \$300 is required. At this meeting all parents and dancers will be given a copy of our "Team Contract" and will be asked to sign a commitment to abide by the rules, guidelines, expectations, etc. of the Sugar 'Canes Dance Team.

Upon signing the attached 2025-2026 Audition Application Form, as well as giving your child permission to tryout for the MHS Sugar 'Cane Dance Team, you are also committing to the Financial Responsibilities as outlined above should your daughter make the team.

NOTE: For any family/dancer that makes the team with financial hardships, limited scholarships are available each year. Please speak with Coach Kourtney for more info.
