



Manatee High School College Preparatory Academy

Additional Information for Students Who Do Not Attend Public Schools in Manatee County

The following items must be submitted with your application for the College Preparatory Academy:

- Final report card from previous year
- Standardized assessments from previous year. Students must earn at least 70% in composite scores for Reading and Math and at least 50% in Science and Social Studies.
- Semester 1 grades from current year

Official acceptance is not determined until the final grades and the standardized test results for this year are submitted and reviewed. Students and/or parents are responsible for submitting this information as soon as it is available to Mrs. Nance. They may be mailed to, or dropped off at, Manatee High School.

State Assessments

According to the most recent state law, all students graduating from a public high school must take Algebra 1, Biology, Geometry, and US History End-of-course exams. They must pass the Algebra 1 EOC. If you have taken one of these courses already, you might want to take the assessment during our testing schedule in May or in the summer.

- To test in May during the school day you must contact the District office.
- To test during the summer, you must FIRST enroll at Manatee High School. Then, contact our testing coordinator (Charles Gage) or assistant principal (Kathleen Brown) to schedule a date for testing.

School Enrollment and Class Registration Process

Once you are tentatively accepted into the College Preparatory Academy, you must enroll in Manatee High School and register for classes. To complete the school enrollment process you will need to meet with our registrar. Please bring the following items:

- School enrollment forms (can be found on school website)
- Original immunization records (Florida State Immunization Form 680)
- Student's Birth Certificate or valid Passport
- Proof of Residence (electric or water bill in enrolling parent's name)
- Withdrawal form, transcript, or last report card from previous School
- Enrolling parent's government issued picture ID
