These credentials provide the knowledge and practical skills to work in a variety of fitness facilities including health spas, corporate and community fitness centers and beyond. Academy members have the opportunity to volunteer and shadow health related professionals in our local communities. Students learn basic patient care under the direct supervision of licensed clinicians and are able to explore all areas of health related professions.

Students in this program are eligible to participate in HOSA – Future Health Professionals, a national student organization. HOSA's two-fold mission is to promote career opportunities in the healthcare industry and enhance quality healthcare delivery to all people. HOSA provides a unique program of leadership development, motivation, and recognition for students enrolled in health occupation educational classes.

Several industry certifications are available to students, allowing them to demonstrate workforce-ready skills.
