Course Requests and Dual Enrollment for 2025-2026 - Course Request Time is Here for 2025-26 School Year:

Students will be receiving their Course Request Forms on:

- Grade 11 February 3 through US History classes. Due back to same teacher on Thursday, February 6.
- Grade 10 February 10 through Personal Financial Money Management or Economics classes. Due back to same teacher on Thursday, February 13.
- Grade 9 February 18 through English classes. Due back to same teacher on Friday, February 21.

Students should write down their questions for when they meet individually with their school counselors in March/April to review their courses and graduation requirements. Changes may be made at that time.

If a student does not have one of the above classes, they may see their school counselor for their form. Lost Form? Please print off a new one of the <u>Guidance page</u> of the MHS website and turn that one in. That is also where students can access the Curriculum Guide.

Dual Enrollment for the 2025-26 School Year:

Any student wanting to dual enroll with SCF or USF for the first time, must attend a mandatory dual enrollment meeting with a parent/guardian on February 20 at 6:00 pm in the Davis Theater. Any student wanting to dual enroll with MTC will need to make an appointment with their parent/guardian and their school counselor.

NHS Tutoring - For students that may need extra help in any of their classes – encourage them to attend our National Honor Society (NHS) FREE tutoring every Thursday in the media center 2:30-3:30pm. They don't need to sign up (though if it's an advanced level class reach out to Mrs. Hofstra to ensure a capable tutor is available) and they can stay for as long as they need in our time frame. It may even be a great time for them just to set aside to complete homework or a project.
