**Dual Enrollment for the 2025-2026 School Year** - There are three Dual Enrollment options for the 2025-2026 School Year - the University of South Florida, State College of Florida or Manatee Technical College. Students wanting to Dual Enroll with USF or SCF will need to attend the mandatory Dual Enrollment meeting on February 20, 2025 with their parents/ guardians. The meeting is at 6pm in the MHS Davis Theater.

The PERT Test for Dual Enrollment for State College of Florida (SCF) or for University of South Florida (USF) will be given at MHS on Tuesday, January 28, 2025. Students with a 3.0 or larger GPA may register to take this test. Eligible Honors Algebra 2 students will automatically be registered for this test. Students/parents may attend any of the workshops. To begin the application the student and parent must have an FSA ID.
