

BRMS S.A.C. Meeting Minutes 09/10/19 5:33 p.m.

- ~ Rezoning with Marie Gutierrez for the 2020/2021 school year.
- ~ Introduction of SAC chair members, principal and administration.
- ~ Approval of minutes from April 2019. Approved, “ayes” have it.
- ~ Principal’s Report with Mrs. Zenon-Richardson
- ~ School grade B+, goal for next year A+. Plan for success A+B+C, academics, behavior and culture. Every class has a “reflection station”, school motto and admin and teachers are in the hallways before, during and after school.
- ~ How are we doing so far? Pulling data after progress reports, district assessment happens in October 2019, literacy plan (reading, writing, responding) and rubrics.
- ~ Behavior: Compared 18/19 referral data to 19/20 data to date. Dress code and school id with lanyards have improved.
- ~ Culture: Dress for success! Lanyard with id, sleeves, no rips and fingertip length on clothing.
- ~ Safety and Security: Random scans, id with lanyard, seated by class at lunch, class doors locked, secure campus, bathroom passes, training and mandatory monthly drills.
- ~ Blue Ribbon Schools of Excellence (BRSE): Survey emails have gone out and deadline for that is 09/16/19. More participation is needed with 30% completion. BRMS is looking for a BRSE team of parents. The parent meet and greet will be on Thursday Sept 26th from 8:15 – 9:15 (ish).
- ~ Overall budget: Funds allocated for the 2019/20 school year. Paper and copying remains the biggest expense. Teachers are given a certain amount and fundraising will happen to help with this expense.
- ~ Other Information: Re-zoning committee, 924 current enrollment, BRMS was allocated for a staff for 954 students. BRMS did lose one unit (science) due to the enrollment numbers.
- ~ Renovations: BRMS has been moved up on the list for renovations.

~ Questions: Metal detectors are being used at the school with a random number picked each day. One parent signed up for the BRSE parent committee.
