Manatee High School is providing 9th and 11th grade students the opportunity to take a standardized assessment to gauge their college readiness. This is an optional test and is not a graduation requirement. Any 11th grader that would like to be eligible for the National Merit Scholarship Program needs to take the PSAT.

The School District of Manatee County has chosen to use the PSAT/NMSQT for this assessment opportunity, which aligns with the SAT, a college entrance exam used by most colleges and universities. This assessment will be administered during the school day on October 22nd or 23rd. The PSAT/NMSQT is more than just a test – it is a comprehensive program that helps schools put students on the path to college. PSAT/NMSQT benefits include:

- encouraging participation in Advanced Placement courses
- supporting college and career planning
- preparing students for the SAT and providing access to personalized recommendations for instruction and practice **b** help students fill their knowledge gaps through Khan Academy
- providing scholarship opportunities when students participate in the 11th grade (National Merit Scholarship Program)

While the information received from this assessment is valuable and relevant, there is also an understanding of the substantial time set aside for required testing throughout the school year. In consideration of this, if you would like your student to take advantage of this opportunity, you will need to pay \$18 by using the link on the Manatee High School website by August 21st, by paying for the test you will automatically be registered to take the PSAT.
