





Student Identification

- Student IDs must be worn on a lanyard around the neck, in front of the body
- •All students will receive a FREE student ID.
- ■Reprints are \$5.
- Only current year PHS student IDs allowed
- Not tied to backpack or clipped on waist/shirt

Late to School (Tardy) Policy



- Students who arrive late must check in with the front office
- Parents may write a note or come inside to sign the student in 3 excused times per quarter.
- If a bus is late, students will be excused and given a pass to class



- Meal payments




Deliveries


