AP/EOC Courses: Seniors enrolled in an AP or EOC course will receive an assigned date and time for exams. Seniors who must take an EOC will receive a separate notice of their testing date & location. If there is a conflict, a senior should attend their AP or EOC assigned exam and work with their teacher to schedule a make up exam.

Exemption Qualifications: Student must have a B or higher 3rd quarter AND a B or higher 4th quarter (not the semester average). **No exemptions are allowed for dual enrollment, AP, or EOC courses.** Exemptions are at the discretion of the teacher.

Students will receive an Exemption Sign Off form on Monday, May 3. This will be the student's pass to arrive late or leave early based on the exam schedule. If a student is not leaving during other non-exam classes, the student will follow their normal schedule and will not cause any disruption to the regular school day, classes, or teachers when not scheduled for an exam. When on campus, seniors will adhere to all school policies, including those for behavior, IDs, and dress code.
