## **Eighth Grade**

- Core Subjects: All 8th graders must pass a full year of each of the four core subjects. Final Placement will be determined by teacher recommendation and FSA scores.
- Advanced course prerequisite: Level 3 or above on the most current required state assessment or teacher recommendation and 3.0 GPA
- High School Course Requirements: <u>English 1 Honors</u>: 3 or higher on ELA FSA or have both teacher recommendation and 3.5 GPA in 7<sup>th</sup> grade Advanced ELA. <u>Algebra 1 Honors</u>: 3 or higher on Mathematics FSA or have both teacher recommendation and 3.5 GPA in 7<sup>th</sup> grade Advanced Mathematics. <u>Geometry Honors</u>: C or higher in each semester of Algebra 1 Honors and must have passed the Algebra EOC. <u>Spanish 1</u>: 4 or higher on the ELA FSA or have teacher recommendation and 3.0 GPA in Advanced ELA <u>Spanish 2</u>: teacher recommendation and 3.0 GPA in Spanish 1.
