Prepared

You should always be prepared **EVERY** day for **EVERY** class. This requires you to have the daily assignment, materials, and /or supplies needed for class. Be ready to learn!

Punctual

You should always be on time and ready to be a student. School starts promptly at 7:30 a.m. with five minutes between classes. You will be considered tardy if you are not in your classroom when the tardy bell rings. Consequences are rendered for an unexcused tardy. If you are a car rider or driver, be mindful to leave early enough to arrive on time.

Take traffic into consideration when factoring your time. There are two car rider loops, the east and west side of campus. **The Administration parking lot IS NOT a parent loop. Please respect the request of not using the admin parking lot to drop off and pick up your student.**

Proper

You should wear clothes that are appropriate and proper for school. Five main areas of the dress code are:

1. Shorts/skirts/dresses must be a minimum of fingertip length when standing straight up.
2. All shirts must be long enough that no skin is visible when the arms are fully raised.
3. Any top (shirt or dress) must cover the entire front, back, and shoulders at fingertip length with leggings.
4. All pants, shorts, etc., must be properly fastened and worn at the waist.
5. No slits, holes, or frays exposing skin are permissible above the fingertip.

Participate

On the first day of school, you will receive a student handbook with the school expectations, procedures, and policies. There are a variety of sports, activities, infinities, and clubs to give students a wide range of choices. **Get INVOLVED.**
