Monday, January 24 th	Launch into Literacy Day & The Great Kindness Challenge Wear Sunglasses today Literacy Challenge: Read a book Outside Book Suggestion - New Kid by Jerry Craft Kindness Challenge: Send a family member a picture of yourself smiling, and tell them one reason why they make you happy
Tuesday, January 25 th	Literacy and Kindness Tie us together – Wear a tie today Literacy Activity: Decorate a bookmark Book Suggestion- Inside Out and Back Again, by Thanhha Lai Kindness challenge: Write one thing you love about your past self, present self, and future self (3 things total) on a card. Decorate it and hang it up so you see it often!
Wednesday, January 26 th	Rocket to Kindness — Wear green Wednesday for unity! Literacy Activity: Can you guess the teacher and their favorite book? Book Suggestion- Modoc: The Story of the World's Greatest Elephant, Ralph Helfer Kindness challenge: Write a short, anonymous poem or note about why the world is beautiful and why everyone deserves kindness. Post it in a public space.
Thursday, January 27 th	It takes a team- Wear a shirt that supports a team (sports or any kind of club/team) Literacy Activity: Play book charades or act out a scene from a book Book Suggestion- The Wall by Eve Bunting Kindness challenge: Go for a walk and identify 5 things you are grateful for that exist within a 10 minute walk of where you live.
Friday, January 28 th	Out of this world socks- Wear crazy socks *students who donate a pair of socks can participate in uniform buyout day! Literacy activity: Bring a flashlight and read in the dark.
