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<p>Monday, January 24th</p>	<p>Launch into Literacy Day & The Great Kindness Challenge <u>Wear Sunglasses today</u> Literacy Challenge: Read a book Outside Book Suggestion - New Kid by Jerry Craft Kindness Challenge: Send a <u>family member</u> a picture of yourself smiling, and tell them one reason why they make you happy</p>

<p>Wednesday, January 26th</p>	<p>Rocket to Kindness – <u>Wear green Wednesday for unity!</u> Literacy Activity: Can you guess the teacher and their favorite book? Book Suggestion- <u>Modoc: The Story of the World's Greatest Elephant</u>, Ralph Helfer Kindness challenge: Write a short, anonymous poem or note about why the world is beautiful and why everyone deserves kindness. Post it in a public space.</p> 
<p>Thursday, January 27th</p>	<p>It takes a team- <u>Wear a shirt that supports a team</u> (sports or any kind of club/team) Literacy Activity: Play book charades or act out a scene from a book Book Suggestion- <u>The Wall</u> by Eve Bunting Kindness challenge: Go for a walk and identify 5 things you are grateful for that exist within a 10 minute walk of where you live.</p> 
<p>Friday, January 28th</p>	<p>Out of this world socks- <u>Wear crazy socks</u> <i>*students who donate a pair of socks can participate in uniform buyout day!</i> Literacy activity: Bring a flashlight and read in the dark. Book Suggestion- <u>Each Kindness</u> by Jacqueline Woodson Kindness challenge: Reach out/give to those in need</p>
