General Choice Information

- Any incoming Kindergarten student or student not currently enrolled in Manatee County public schools wishing to apply for Open Enrollment Choice must present a certified birth certificate as proof of age eligibility.
REQUIRED Enrolling Parent signature verified via either notary or cross reference of current EP email address on file with SDMC student information system (FOCUS).
A student's assigned zone school is the school in the boundary area based on the geographical location of the enrolling parent home address. A student's choice school is the school approved to attend instead of the assigned zone school. Choice options include schools shared within Middle School Regions, Elementary Clusters and IB or AICE programs.
To be eligible for choice transportation, the student must live more than two miles away from the Choice School and not in any restricted outlying area as indicated by the Office of Student Assignment.
Completing an application for Open Enrollment does not guarantee assignment to a Choice School.
Applications for School Choice considered based on school capacity, the student's proximity to the Choice School, and on other race-neutral factors.
Students may apply to cross-region/cluster schools by submitting a Hardship Request Form. Transportation is not provided for hardship assignments.
Students may choose a school only once a year and are expected to complete at least one school year at the school they have chosen.
