

## Cambridge AICE Parent Alliance (CAPA) Scholarship

CAPA was created to support the students enrolled in the Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Program offered at Palmetto High School. In addition, it also supports the Cambridge AICE parents and faculty. Due to their successful fundraising efforts, they are now offering one scholarship to a senior who has been entered to earn the Cambridge AICE Diploma. The scholarship amount is \$500.

### **Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must be a senior at Palmetto High School and be entered to earn the Cambridge AICE Diploma
- Must have completed 100 volunteer/work hours for Bright Futures Scholarship
- ➤ Must have an unweighted GPA of 3.5 or higher

#### **Information Needed for the Application:**

- ➤ Official PHS Transcript, through Semester 1 of the senior year (in a sealed envelope)
- > Proof that you have been entered to earn the Cambridge AICE Diploma
- > Two letters of recommendation, at least one from a PHS faculty member
- ➤ Proof of completed FAFSA Application
- Acceptance Letter from a college (4-year, 2-year, technical college)
- ➤ Documented 100 community service/work hours
- > Single type-written page answering the following questions:
  - 1. What is your chosen college major? Why did you choose this major?
  - 2. How has the Cambridge AICE Program helped prepare you for college?
