What is Title 1?



Title I is a federally funded entitlement program that provides supplemental resources to higher poverty schools.

These resources are intended to:

- Promote high academic achievement for all children
- Improve teaching and learning
- Increase parent and family engagement

- **Aumentar la participacion de los padres y la familia**






Title 1 Funding








Title 1 Funding

- Parental involvement activities, resources, and communications



How We Measure Learning!



- The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (F.A.S.T.)

- 3 times a year for K-5
 - Fall, Winter, Spring
- Statewide Science Assessment (grades 5)
 - End of year for just 5th grade
- ACCESS for ELLs 2.0
 - January-March
- District quarterly assessments, diagnostics, and school-based assessments for progress monitoring



- ✓ Did you know that children who miss 18 or more days of the school year (2 days a month) starting in kindergarten are less likely to learn to read by third grade and graduate from high school?




Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school—and themselves. Start building this habit early so they learn right away that going to school on time, **every day is important**. Eventually good attendance will be a life-long skill that will help them throughout their lives.

Parent/Guardian Right to Know

- To be involved and request regular meetings to express your opinions and concerns;
- To be provided information on your child's level of achievement on assessments;
- To request and receive information on the qualifications of your child's teachers and paraprofessionals;
- To be informed if your child is taught by a non-state certified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks.

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
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
