• 2024-2025 SIP Goals

- ❖ Goal #1: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, there will be a 6% increase in achievement for our SWD subgroup as evident by the PM3 FAST.
- ❖ Goal #2: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, there will be a 15% increase in achievement for all students in science and a 5% increase in ELA.
- ❖ Goal #3: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, there will be a 5% increase in achievement for all students in Math as evident by the PM3 FAST.
- ❖ Goal #4: By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, there will be a 10% decrease in student achievement regression, from Level 5 to Level 4 and from Level 3 to Level 2, as evident by the PM3 FAST.

Safety & Security

- Per new Florida house bill, any entrance or exit into the school campus must be either always locked or physically guarded

- School is working to get swipe card access to the most frequent used doors and an exception for both the rear gate to the dumpster area and the yellow gate in front of the car rider pickup line
