

1/27/20 SAC Meeting – Minutes

Call to order 6:30

Kundrat not present – meeting run by Sloman

Approval of Decemer 2019 minutes. Motion to approve by Howard, seconded by Stroup. Motion approved.

Administrator’s Report – Sloman

3rd quarter under way.

Much participation by Haile county fair. Haile steer, Napoleon, won his class. Class winner in swine and an art project won 2nd. Very successful for our students.

Basketball season has started. Both boys and girls won first game. Second game vs. Mona Jaine tomorrow.

Band participating in Big Band Brawl at Braden River tomorrow at 6:00 pm

FTE Survey is underway until 2/7. All students need to be present at least one day during survey. This is how funding is received. If student is not present, we lose funding for that child.

PLW on 2/5 and 2/6 is posting of progress report.

Benchmark projections show us on track to maintain and improve A school score as compared to last year.

No school 2/17 for President’s Day.

Barlaug – **State of the District presentation.** (posted on website)

Updates to technology around campus. We will be close to a one to one school for lap tops. Screens for all classrooms within the next month or two.

Haile scheduled for updates to buildings and structures.

Barlaug – **dress code discussion.** Still short the votes needed to move forward. Would like to table and revisit in the fall.

Sloman – **lighting issues** at parent pick up for after school activities – also no cover against weather. Safety is a concern. Mrs. Barlaug will bring up the safety and securities concerns to the district.

Gardner – **students not supposed to be dropped off prior to 8:45?** Some parents not following rules and causing issues for other parents who are waiting. We are technically not responsible for students

until 8:45 if something should happen. Flanigan- Could YMCA do a drop-in program for the occasional issue? Barlaug will ask. Will also put reminders out again during call outs. Pot hole needs to be fixed.

Referral Process – Wood. What is the actual process for discipline referrals. All referrals receive due process, but one set of exact steps is not possible because it depends on the type and severity of referral. Referrals are entered into FOCUS by teacher, deans will be notified and speak to both the student and the teacher, consequences issued according to matrix. Parents notified. Change to the system only allows the district to remove a referral.

Deputy Patterson **request for funding for registration fee** for summer conference. \$400 is available in the mini-grant funds. Flanigan motioned to approve, Piantanida seconds. Approved unanimously. Deputy will report after attending.

Requests for Agenda Items – sound issues in loud areas such as chorus or orchestra (K. Wade) Mrs. Barlaug has already addressed this with the district. May be addressed this summer.

Is there an app that allows teachers to communicate directly with parents? (Remind or Class Dojo?)

Next meeting – nothing scheduled for March. Keep February on the calendar for now, but if nothing to discuss may cancel. Will schedule another for April maybe May. Make sure items that need to be discussed are forwarded to Kundrat. FSA Writing would be prior to April 20 meeting if February is scheduled. Testing schedules have not been published yet, but with computers and personnel now available, hoping to reduce testing 6 days rather than 12 and allows time between tests. Waiting for district approval.

March 4 – Class registration for all grade levels. 5th grade will be here March 10 for tour and they will receive registration forms after Spring Break.
