

8/31/20 SAC Meeting Minutes

Introduction by Principal Barlaug

Admin Report - Sloman

First 2 weeks went very well.

14 New additions to staff, 11 new teachers, 4 new openings.

775 students, 222, Hybrid, 239 e-learning, the rest brick and mortar.

Fundraiser kicked off on 27th – packets when home with students – completely on-line – runs through 9/17

No School next Monday for Labor Day

All doors locked until 8:45 each morning. Deputy Patterson patrols campus regularly. Never without an SRO if she has to be off campus.

Covid 19 Update - Barlaug

Many safety precautions in place. Appear to be working. No positive cases on campus so far.

Masks worn all day except at lunch; one-way hallways barring inclement weather; lunch and science rooms have dividers; teachers have spaced desks as much as possible; teachers/students wipe down surfaces after every period; sanitizer for students; custodians keeping up with high contact surfaces. Students are doing very well. Few to know complaints and students are complying with few issues. Parents being very cooperative keeping kids at home when they are sick. Students/staff fill out a questionnaire each day. Any possible exposures sent or kept at home for 14 days or if symptoms. 10 days from a positive test. Students can return earlier after a negative test.

Teachers posting everything on Schoology to keep continuity for students to work at home. Much more focused and streamlined this year. Higher expectations of students. Teachers teaching multiple grade levels and are sharing lessons and videos so students may see other teachers via video.

Open for Questions:

Mahoney – What is the protocol if a student identified as positive? Mrs. Barlaug went through the required district protocol. Exposure is 6ft for more than 15 minutes of direct contact.

Morgan: IF a teacher or child has symptoms can they be required to have a test? Cannot be required, but is recommended. Can students come back sooner if no symptoms? So far no parents have requested to come back sooner – unless they have had a negative test.
