### Guidelines:

\*You must be employed at your OJT Eligible job prior to the start of the school year.

\*OJT eligible jobs must be related to food, fiber, and/or natural resources.

\*Job locations must be within a 10-mile radius of Braden River High School. Not South of Beeridge, not North of Moccasin Wallow, not East of 675, and not west of SR 41.

\*Students may not be employed by family members.

\*You must be a Junior or Senior in a level 3 or 4 Agriculture course. Some exceptions MAY be made for seniors in a level 2 course with exemplary grades and behavior.

\*Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher and no frequent ISS or any OSS days.

\*For each period of OJT, you must be working at least 7.5 hours per week.

\*All paperwork will be given out the first day of class and must be returned before you can log hours at your job.
