- 1) Welcome (Daniel Bradshaw): 6:01 p.m.
- 2) Introductions: 6:02 p.m.

- 3) SAC Reports: 6:06 p.m.
 - a. Minutes – 6:06 p.m.
 - i. Motioned was made by A. Bergmann to approve minutes, seconded by C. Auckerman SAC Minutes from March 9th, 2020 were approved with attendance modification.
 - b. Financial Report – 6:10 p.m.
 - i. Nothing to report at this time; waiting on district
- 4) Principal’s Report (Auckerman): 6:11 p.m.
 - a. PSAT 10/14/20 (Auckerman): 6:11 p.m.
 - i. Administered on campus on October 14th to all sophomores; juniors and freshman if they choose to pay
 - b. Drainage Project (Auckerman): 6:12 p.m.
 - i. Retention ponds by football and baseball fields have been enlarged to deepen the ponds and tree removal allowed to expand ponds
 - ii. Valve to release and regulate water from the retention pond into Terra Ciera bay
 - iii. About 75% done with project but continue to look for ways to improve
 - iv. ~ \$800,000 worth of improvement; seems to be working thus far
 - v. Q: What does it look like now? (R. Kendzior)
A: Looks good, only standing water by building 6 when observed today (C. Auckerman) There is an improvement
 - c. AICE Results 19/20 (Bradshaw): 6:19 p.m.
 - i. 914 passing scores in 2019; 1279 passing scores in 2020
 - ii. 55 AICE diplomas in 2019; 75 AICE diplomas in 2020
 - iii. Scores were revised after initial release as previous scores were weighted too much...a global rescore was done in beginning of August 2020
 - iv. Each passing score receives funds from the district

- d. School Improvement Plan – Progress Monitoring (Simmons): 6:24 p.m.
 - i. Submitted on September 11th
 - ii. Our goals set for last year are the same as FSA scores were incomplete
 - iii. Next meeting will have the goal list sent out once list is fully updated with team lead inputs
 - iv. Final draft is due next week, corrections will be made this week
 - v. Final draft will be given to SAC committee at next meeting

- e. 10 – Day Count Allocations (Bradshaw): 6:28 p.m.
 - i. Enrollment numbers, 2079 students on campus which is 30 students over; were able to add one teacher unit
 - ii. New schedules were made today (Sept 14) as students were leveled out with the new allocation in place
 - iii. Almost 400 students effected by schedule changes

- f. School Safety (Simmons): 6:30 p.m.
 - i. Unexpected visitor last week – Safety Investigator from DOE
 - ii. Took tour of the school and was very happy as she checked locked doors, checked for the “hard corners” in the classrooms
 - iii. Asked about how drills were being implemented with social distancing
 - iv. One area of improvement: PA system to make sure students can hear announcements clearly
 - v. District came through and put black covering over door windows that can be rolled down when needed
 - vi. Drills will be done in sections as social distancing will be maintained
 - vii. Received new fencing that went around the entire school
