- 1. **Call to Order and Welcome:** A meeting of the Anna Maria School Advisory Committee was held on April 14, 2022. David Zaccagnino called the meeting to order at 3:53 pm. Ivory Graham will record the minutes for this meeting.
- 2. **Review and Approval February 10, 2022 SAC minutes.** A review was done of the minutes from the Feb 2022 SAC meeting. - 5. **Building Improvements**. Mr. Masiello provided information on the status of building projects. The auditorium roof has been replaced. Installation of new playground equipment and new covered area structure has been delayed until summer.
- 6. **Programs/Events Update:** Dinners before grade level play performances are scheduled to return next school year.
- 7. **Safety Update:** New swing gates have been added to entrances to the school campus, additional security cameras and lighting for the grove area are scheduled to be installed.
- 8. **SAC Self Evaluation**. The SAC members rated the performance of the committee as overall highly effective. Requirements have been met for SAC membership.
- 9. **Other:** An acceleration program will be implemented next year at all district elementary schools for students in grades, 3, 4, and 5. ELA acceleration for grades 3-5 and Math acceleration for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade. Math acceleration will be offered for 5<sup>th</sup> grade in the 2023-2024 school year. Students will qualify for acceleration based on data such as scores from state and district assessments.
- 10. No lottery funds will be provided next year. This is the same as the current school year. Millage funds were provided to conduct after school tutoring and collaborative planning. Funds provided in the future may be used in the same manner.
