AGENDA ITEMS

1. Welcome & Call to Order

- 7 of 10 SAC voting members were in attendance as such quorum was reached

2. Officer Vote

- There were no volunteers for the roles of SAC chair or co-chair for the 2021-2022 school year
- There were three possibilities discussed for new officers; 1) extend the current officers by another year, 2) current officers remain until the beginning of the following or 3) add an amendment to the SAC by-laws that allows officers to remain for an additional year in certain circumstances
- Mrs. Danowski suggested extending Nadia Wood and Coach Wilson by another year in light of Covid and the unusual previous two years with permission from District.
- Next steps – the SAC members motioned that Mrs. Danowski will contact District to ask for the extension. If this will not be allowed, then the SAC will add an amendment to the by-laws to allow for an extension to time served in certain circumstances.

3. Testing Schedule

- I-Ready testing has already started and will go through May 13th
- 4th and 5th grade ELA testing will take place on 5/4 and 5/5. The testing will not count but will help the teachers with important information.
- 3rd grade ELA is completed.
- Math FSA's are 5/18 and 5/19
- 90% of the kids will be tested, but District will decide on whether or not school grades will be issued
- Freedom is being projected to receive a high B grade, but are hoping to push to an A
- They are encouraging students to do their best.
- 3rd graders still have to pass something to move forward to 4th grade (either Benchmarks, FSA or I-ready)

- 5th grade end of the year celebration through car rider- May 26th
