2021-22 School Data Reviewed

- FSA data for ELA, Math, Science, Gains. L25 was shared
- Grade Scale was shared and how do you get a school grade was shared
 - Target is our goal
 - top bucket(ELA 28% scored 3 or greater), next bucket math (40% scored 3 or greater)ect.
- Our goal is closing the gap
- Families were asked to review FSA Score 3rd-8th and look for patterns
- iReady data was reviewed
 - *k-2 is struggling in phonic/ phonemic, so those grades are working in small groups with Literacy FootPrints
- Principal charged the parents with reviewing where the students are in iReady and seeing their reading level. This can be done by contacting the teacher.
- Acaletic data was reviewed. The goal for September was 20%. It was explained that it tests all standards for the year and the goal goes up each month. There are incentives each month, which is called the "Green Party". Some of the incentives have included ice cream, Kona Ice ect...
- History of scores was reviewed. The growth was shown from 2018-19 and it was discussed what it took to make that happen.
