- I. Welcome and Approval of Minutes- Mr. Dahlquist

- III. Old Business
 - a. Review/Approve SAC By-Laws
Mrs. Mendle expresses that under the state statute you may not restrict the number of voting members. The principle may also appoint parents to vote to meet demographics. Mr. Dalquist states that he is waiting for a final verdict from Dr. Criag if he needs to appoint more members; however, at this meeting, we are following the current bylaws. The by-laws that were adjusted at our last meeting in May have not yet been made. By the next meeting, the by-laws will be updated and voted upon. Mr. Dahlquist also states that the exterior of the school will be painted sometime this school year and the interior during the summer. We are the only high school in Manatee county that was placed on the School of Excellence list as well as rated an “A” school. The seniors have an assembly with a school speaker

Wednesday (9/18) during third period. Many exciting and positive things are happening on campus including sports, band, and JROTC. Overall, Mr. Dahlquist expresses that we have a lot to be thankful for here at LRHS.

VI. Student Update

SGA is very busy preparing for homecoming, which is October 5th. Our theme this year is “There’s No Place like Home-Coming”, based on the Wizard of Oz. We had our first pep rally of the year last Friday and we had a great turnout; there was even a flash mob that some LRHS staff participated in! For the sports update; our football team won again this past Friday during a USA-themed game vs. North Port. They are currently 3-0, making them undefeated for the first time in a while! There is no game this week, as it’s their bye week. The volleyball team had a tournament this weekend in Orlando, where they placed 2nd in the silver division. Their next home game is this Thursday at home vs. our rivals, Braden River. All three teams (freshman, JV, and varsity) will play, and the game will be a whiteout. The cross country team has their 3rd meet this weekend in North Port, for both the girls’ and boys’ teams.
