- I. Welcome and Approval of Minutes- Mr. Dahlquist
Mr. Mendel makes the motion to approve the November minutes, Ms. Mount seconds, the minutes are passed unanimously.

- II. New Business
 - a. School Recognition Funds Vote
 - i. Ms. Mendel began talking about voting on the A+ money. The group of teachers met to discuss how the money will be spent. The committee evenly distributed the money throughout all of our campus' employees. Mr. Galeziowski makes the motion to approve, Mr. Mendel seconds, passed unanimously.
 - b. 2020-2021 Student Registration
 - i. Teachers have submitted requests for new courses to be offered. For example, AP Computer Science Principles and Acting 1 will be offered for the upcoming year. Next week, counselors will start their classroom visits. They're going to see the rising seniors and try to tackle what requirements and classes they'll need to graduate. Ms. Galinda explained how the enrollment forms are supposed to be due to Feb. 10th, but it's unlikely that the goal will be met since the curriculum guide hasn't been published yet. The 8th-grade meeting will be Feb. 27th for students zoned to Lakewood Ranch. She began to explain how the school is experiencing no relief when it comes to overcrowding, despite the new high school being opened. In the first week of March, counselors will be off-campus visiting middle schoolers who are planning on attending Lakewood Ranch next year.
During March to May, counselors will sit with every single student at Lakewood Ranch to go over graduation requirements.

- III. Principal Update

- a. Mr. Dalquist explained how the seniors are getting excited about graduation, citing how we are on track for a 95% graduation rate. He also said how students from Lakewood Ranch won 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place at the Palm of Youth M.L.K. celebration this past Friday.

- a. This week is a very busy week for sports- baseball began their tryouts yesterday, softball and tennis started today, and lacrosse has started their conditioning for their upcoming season. Basketball is in full swing, they have a game tonight and have their rivalry game vs. Braden River this Friday. The boy's soccer team's senior night is tonight as well. FFA is busy with the fair this week, with many students competing, showing their pigs, cows, and even showing some plants. TSA is also busy preparing for their state conference next month. The student government has just begun planning its annual dodgeball tournament to benefit F.E.L.T. (Feeding empty little tummies). The tournament will be March 11th, and boys and girls in every grade level have the opportunity to compete in it. The theater department is about to begin their performances of Mamma Mia, starting at the beginning of February. The marching band Performed in the Palmetto M.L.K. parade this weekend. The concert band is preparing for their solo and ensemble competitions and MPA's. Finally, the silver stars got third place yesterday at the Florida dance championships.
