#### Student IDs

- Students must wear a BRHS ID at all Times.
- 9th Grade students will get ID's made during the 1st week of school or after this presentation in the media center.
- IDs are used in the cafeteria for buying lunch, for the computers in the media center, and for signing in and out of school.
- Students will need to purchase a new ID if it is lost. The cost is \$5.00 and can be purchased before or after school in the Media Center.

#### **Dress Code**

- Follow School Board Policy and Procedure. Check your Student Handbook for the complete dress code.
- Follow the code. ASK before you WEAR it.
  - You may not have ANY Pants/Skirts/Shorts with exposed skin above midthigh length.
  - All bottoms must be at least midthigh length. Bottoms must stay in dress code at all times.
  - Leggings, spandex type or lycra type material bottoms must be covered with a top that is midthigh length.
  - ALL shirts must have sleeves. No Sleeveless or spaghetti strap tops/dresses.
  - No Pajamas or clothing intended to be sleepwear. No house slippers or shoes intended to for sleepwear.
  - Sheer material can only be worn if clothing underneath is in full dress code.
  - All undergarments must be covered at all times. All clothing intended to be worn as an undergarment must be covered.
  - No tops that only reach the top of bottoms. Shirts must be long enough to cover entire abdomen at ALL TIMES.

## Tardy Policy

- Start of School Day
  - After 7:30 am, report to Student Services.
  - Only 2 parent excused tardies per quarter (Bring note)
  - Doctor's Note / Proper Documentation Required to be excused
- Between Classes
  - 4 minutes
  - Late: Go to Student Services
  - 1 emergency pass per class per quarter
- Tardy Consequence: After School Detention

## Leaving Campus Early


